Heqk. and said Uncle they asked me to stay  
to-day What do you think. Uncle asks which  
man calls you friend. "Kurillo, Dainanagi  
Tsissaga" these 3 don't want me to go  
call me friend Heq says I wouldn't  
believe them while calling you friend. I think  
they want to kill, that's why they call you  
friend. If you fell like it play with them  
to-day. Heqk added Why do you wish to play  
to-day why don't you go on our journey. I  
says I have a friend over there and I like  
to play with him. - ~~Just~~ He says I guess  
we go to-day they want to kill you - I  
didn't believe but went to back to people  
but saw my Uncle wants to go away to-day  
Lorane says I want you to stay to-day don't  
you believe him I'm not going to kill  
you I remained they set out to run, I  
ran too with geese & salmon <sup>and buzzard</sup> and all the  
other people. I beat them all. Chief says  
says to people I want you all to stop you  
can't beat that man. ~~People~~  
Hokwina Leggaga Tsispina Lalaji  
wouldn't give up. said we don't want to  
stop we want to beat him. All right said  
I if you want to keep it up all day I'll  
stay with you. If you beat me. all right  
about sundown I'll go over to my Uncle  
they <sup>said</sup> wanted to give him food but he wouldn't  
take any. The people said we'd like to see  
your Uncle what kind of man he is but I  
said I don't want you fellows to go over  
He went to Uncle and returned then said  
I'll go home tomorrow. If I were alone  
I'd stay three days but my Uncle

letter to go home. Next morning he & small

went south taking the elk with them. Heg I'd like to have you kill the Elk so as to see how they taste. I killed one Heg ate it. <sup>the camp</sup> In the night some people were coming in dark & Heg & I smelt them saw not small good enemies. I said I don't want you to talk so I think those people came to see me I want you to keep aside. I says you like to kill other people too quick that's the reason you don't like em to come. Heg says I don't want you to stop long I want to go home I've say you are going to camp all day I don't want to. I guess we better kill all these elk and then go home. I says ~~that~~ I don't want to kill em I want to take em home on my place Heg say Elk too much better. <sup>kill eyes</sup> I thought I change (turn over the world) why not let me the Elk if you don't let me kill em I kill you. You don't know what I do to you when you get mad. I'll put you to sleep when I want to. I says I fix you too if you go the <sup>20</sup> that way both of us will die.

I says this is the last time I'll talk to you "If you don't want me to take these elk home kill em. Hegk. blew from his mouth killed all the Elk and all the people round about. Heg says you not going to see any ~~more~~ <sup>elk or</sup> people. Then they started south both of em. H killed everything as he went on. Heg says to I I guess I put you away hide you now you H hid me in the best place.

hide = to put away in his hair.

I saw I don't want you to hide me  
I think you want to kill me that's why  
you talk so. Both walked in Southern

H. killing the people as they went with the  
breath of his mouth. as soon as he  
breathed on them they dropped down dead

H. says I won't camp any more but  
travel night and day without stopping  
H says when you started I thought you  
wanted to buy a woman now I guess  
you don't care about a woman.

They kept on South <sup>He's</sup> (killing all he met  
They saw people and kill them far away  
(~~He~~ <sup>He's</sup> want have people alive near at 2  
that's the reason he kill em the people)

They says I thought you going to see  
good people that's the reason I go with  
you but you didn't want to do right  
Sometimes in the day as they are going  
along H rests standing straight & stiff

motionless as a pillar listening for  
people. ~~He~~ if he hears any red matter  
how far he blows at them and then  
and kills them. He now took 2 and

hid him away between his horns. He  
says I'll go <sup>straight</sup> South and go ~~to~~ <sup>to</sup> kill  
right down to Steatpa and go to ~~the~~ <sup>to</sup>  
killing all. I'll keep you put away

now I'll go where I like now I want  
to kill people. H went on killed all he ~~met~~  
met or saw. (Whenever they come to my place  
they kill my people now I kill them H.)  
says) H went on and on till he came to Steitpa

Djarpa. Steilpa. Pansamauna <sup>= way off</sup> ~~South~~ <sup>west</sup>  
 Steilpa = another world ~~South~~  
 Steithama = " " East  
 " Djamma = " " North  
 Steimutji " " West  
 Steimutji

Hey says I think all turn this world  
 up side down 2 says No. dont you  
 I like to see people along way  
 and if you should do so. I could not  
 not. 2 says I'd like to go through the  
 sky (the iron <sup>mountain</sup> f'ä'ea) H. says I dont  
 want you to go through the sky I want you to go  
 home where you came from all right says 2  
 lets go home you dont want me to go through  
 the sky. When Hey hungry he eat the  
<sup>loaf</sup> people ("Indians") 2 awful pretty man  
 says you go home I like to go on  
 down you go home to where you came  
 from. H says why dont we both go home  
 your sisters will think you dead We  
 a long time away. I I like to go out  
 through the sky. H says I dont want  
 you to go through I guess well go back  
~~all day~~ Well says I lets go back. They  
 turned and went back ~~till they came~~  
~~to some place~~ Well we are going home  
 and the people here wont let me  
 alone that's the reason I will see  
 I said nothing on the road. <sup>H killed</sup> <sup>on</sup> ~~the~~ <sup>people that</sup>  
<sup>the way they returned & another road</sup> ~~seen~~ all hills of H. 2 cries on the road  
~~home~~ and said I like to see people but  
 you will kill them all off. H says when near  
 home I want kill people but <sup>when</sup> far from  
 home I will them. When H sees a spring he  
 rests there and drinks 2 says I like to

to talk to them to go to them now  
Well When we are pretty near home you'll  
see our people. I don't like the people  
yet they are too far from our place yet  
these strangers (enemies) Then said  
H after a while if you like to see this  
people all right you can do so all  
draw back my tongue and not blow  
on them. I didn't mind to let you see  
this people, but now go on ahead and  
see them. I says if the people like me  
don't bother don't want to kill me  
all right. Well let them alone if they don't  
try to kill us. As they were coming I said to  
Taine the Sam "I don't want you to go too  
fast. Taine went slow. Hequn didn't kill  
none people he passed them without blowing.  
People not so scared when they see Hequn.  
People like to see I but still shy on  
account of his being with H. On the  
way they came to a big ranchie many people  
Cham Chief. People swans, geese, ducks  
Porultjua they fishes -----

Porultjua went first to see I and said  
he was his friend and said I know your  
brother and where you come from I says yes  
I come from up North. I glad see wish we  
could stop little longer. Now I hides  
Hequn in his head ~~front~~ and goes apparently  
all alone ~~to the ranchie~~ Por says come  
back to the H if you people like us  
I want home I asked his people to go over  
and see "my brother and I wish you to let

time come not molest him. Crane says I dont know maybe not your brother maybe another tribe I ~~and~~ dont believe it. P. says I want you people to go and see - some of them <sup>went</sup> P. too are called all who went broken in land, and said to I I want you to come over to the rancheria I dont <sup>you</sup> be afraid I went. Crane says you give him grub when I came. hawk brought grub. and I smothering his head and face I said she knew that man. Isigfaga friend to I two and said he knew him hawk says this is my people come and see him she calls him nephew all come I greet him. <sup>there</sup> ~~was~~ I says I come from long ways the people <sup>wanted</sup> like to kill me where I was. they didnt treat me well. I wouldnt bother them if they let me alone but they wouldnt

I know you like me right here that's why I <sup>came</sup> my people live here <sup>near</sup> ~~come back~~ <sup>to another rancheria</sup> I said old people tell me that people live here.. and that they are my friends. chief was Crane, stay tomorrow chief said I wasnt afraid anymore. next day the people began to play games shoot arrows, and grass game = <sup>stick</sup> <sup>wrong</sup> Kulaia mitecauma They fed I mail and he ate. Indian grub. sunflower seeds. Jama daca. salmon - and mice - he ate a piece <sup>little bit</sup> at a time - Chief said you can go & play with the people if you like - I mail said this is the way people try to kill me: Chief said dont be afraid they wont bother you that way. He went out to play Meadow lark said to I. sit down dont play much. you go to soon to play with people you should stay quiet - I dont know why you go around so much. old people always staid at home

at Oak Run. perhaps somebody sent you, sit down & tell  
me about your people, perhaps your people all gone,  
long time ago I saw lots of your people - Quail said  
I've got nothing to tell you all my people are dead  
myself & my sister stay alone there. and I heard  
Lark Bryan to cry when she heard what Q. said. she  
said I used to see lots of people at Oak Run, all your  
people - Quail said it is because all my people dead  
that I go off long ways I didn't know that I was  
going to come here. I'd like to stay here two days.  
It seems to me that you have one more man  
Lark - Quail had S. still in his hair - Q. said you  
I've got him right here in my head that is why I go a  
long ways and are not afraid - Looks like I know you  
got him then he is my brother take him out I'd like  
to see him, Q. said no I'll not take him out, maybe  
he won't like me here & will ride the people. He didn't  
take snake out. He told Lark where he had been & what  
people he had killed. Night came, Q. said I'll start  
home to-morrow. I've been away a long time I'd like  
to see my sister. All night Lark said. Don't be afraid  
any more, the Southern people will bother you no  
more. Q. started next morning. Lark said come  
back after a few days & bring your sister, nobody  
at your home she will be lonely - Q. started saw  
people along the road but he only talked to the ones  
killed no more, traveled south, saw all kinds  
of people as he came along. Sundown he camped  
& went out to hunt deer took his flute went up  
on a hill, blew on it and said I want only 3  
deer to come & he made beautiful music. 3  
deer came & he killed them. He left Snake at  
the camp. Cut deer up put all in one hide & took  
it to camp threw it down by snake. all 3 deer  
came out, S. swallowed one & a month later  
Quail said I'll make a fire & roast a little, he



did so. They staid all night - Next morning started on  
again towards Oak Run. The people he met he talked with  
nobody was afraid of him any more. Camped second  
night. - Next day they came on and came to Creek in  
which a water dog. Hatina great man. had a large  
ranch here on the creek. When they got near Snake  
said I smell Hatina and I dont like him - I said dont  
so so, I know when you talk so that you are going to  
Kill people. - Lots of people lived with water dog. some  
of Snake's own people. Now one of the birds said <sup>black bird</sup> Snake  
and he ran back to the ranch here and said I see a person  
coming. What kind of man you see asked Water dog. - He  
said about like our <sup>Sauil</sup> people. They started out to see  
came up to Snake & said I know you we are glad  
to see you. Stay with us to night we have a big Chief. I  
want to ranch. Chief said I want you to talk good to his  
man. They gave him grub. Chief talked to Snake said  
dont be afraid I've got your people here, people like you  
stay to morrow & I'll have my people hunt deer, I'll  
like to feed you one day. and he ordered his men to hunt  
next day. said I'm glad to see this man, he is one  
of my people, next day people hunted deer. Chief  
told women to cook grub & feed him. 3 hours they brought  
home deer. Snake said I didnt come to here you <sup>will</sup>  
feed me I can go myself & kill deer. I didnt <sup>think</sup>  
to go off, but my sister told me to go that's why I went  
After eating all began to play grass game, played  
all afternoon. He said I'll sleep good to night after  
seeing you fellows play, I've been a long ways from  
this place - when I want to see you I'll come back here  
again Snake said - Snake heard everything for he was  
in Snake's hair - Next morning I came on this way

Came a few miles & met a man (Rattle Snake) now  
he took Snake from his hair & put him down on the  
ground when he saw his man. When R. S. saw  
big snake he just just - set down. Rattle S. was going

going north, now S. came up and talked to him.  
R. S. said he was out hunting deer, asked which way  
have you been Brother - S. said I've been a long  
ways. People north never let me alone I thought  
I should never come back to my home. R. S. said  
I guess old people told you not to go north, they knew  
that bad people lived there - S. said I went with  
Quail that's why I went so far - R. S. said I've heard  
old people tell of that place. They always tried to kill  
my people. Come home with me Brother - Quail said  
I don't want to stop long here I want to keep on my road  
home. They were down near Mill Creek now. - Now  
Quail kept on & S. came with him - They met people  
all the way, he didn't shoot deer any more. Camped.  
Sometimes people saw him in the morning, sometimes  
they didn't see him when he camped - S. said I'd like to  
camp here two days I don't know why you are in such a  
hurry we are near our home now, S. said all right -  
They staid 3 days nobody saw them. Then he went & killed  
deer & fed his Uncle brought several & S. ate them all  
Next morning they started, came towards home was  
near home. Camped, somebody came to his camp. There was  
a big ranch man Eagle's ranch. bald headed. all kinds  
of people. Buzzard, Chicken hawk all kinds. The man  
who came to his camp said our chief wants you to come  
to our house. One man was mad, didn't like to see Quail  
it was chicken hawk. he didn't like Quail. Hawk  
said that man killed off my people I don't like him  
Quail said you talk to me that way I'm not afraid of  
you. E. said to H. let him alone I don't want you to get  
up a fight and kill each other this man won't kill  
our people. Hawk began to cry. Q. said people bother  
me in this way that is why I kill them I guess you  
think I'm alone & you are not afraid of me but I've  
got another man with me. Snake heard all they  
said

S. said now you see how people talk if they saw  
me they wouldn't talk this way - B. took S. out &  
put him down, and said these people don't like us  
Snake blew out a breath, & killed every last one  
of the whole great ranch here with one breath - they  
staid all night right there. S. said you needn't hide  
me any more I'll travel myself, and they started  
next morning & as they traveled he kept blowing all  
the time, & it killed every person that happened to  
be near, all kinds of people. - Now every day the  
sister would go out on top the mountain & listen  
if she could hear her brother coming. She said one  
day hum! I smell my uncle I guess they are coming  
now, she was a large woman & wore a bone apron.  
Woman glad. just like wind they came, like  
a great wind. all the way S. blew. - but B. said I wish  
you stop we are near now & I don't want to kill  
people perhaps some of my people are around, but  
S. was big mad & he couldn't make him stop. Killed  
everything. - B. said we are near my home stop uncle  
we are close now. B. set down & thought about  
what he could do. He said he sit down I want to  
talk to you good. and B. begged him to stop. but he wouldn't  
he killed everything. deer & people - Woman heard him  
I smell wind coming it is my uncle - got near  
now S. turned and went off. ~~East~~ west and Quail  
got home, His sister had ~~all~~ all dirt all over she had  
been afraid her brother was killed he was gone so long. she was  
glad to see him. He said when I started I told you  
not to cry. you told me to go off eye for a moment I  
went - all was well & here ends Quail's journey -

## Tiriskala - Eel

I Eel lived on Calover Creek Páwi -  
 Creek and little net which was his S. House  
 Wáwi. - Eel fixed a net to catch salmon, made  
 twine out of reeds, sort of milk comes out when the weed  
 is broken, kind of milk sweet, weed. Eel said now young  
 fellows make lots of string I want net to catch fish  
 I like fish to eat. Eel's people were red hawk (shukon  
 hawk). And how string he was a man & he lived there  
 for you-ma-ti. and wood done, & flint, and skunk  
 and a bird very small. go in bunches, little bit of bird - the  
 O. h. was a little house (now a hill) right on the creek.  
 few birds & bear were of his people. Eel said bring lots  
 of string I want to finish this net. and while I'm gone  
 to fish I want you ~~women~~ to go & dig roots. Eel  
 went down to the creek, fix a willow trap on the edge  
 of the water, and told his people women, fix little sharp  
 shetes & dig roots, I want you to get lots of wood to-morrow  
 I want to dance & sweat, near sundown the  
 women went & get wood. Eel said now & then ~~the~~  
 have a sweat, to-morrow morning you go up on the  
 hill & dig roots the first ripe roots are always by  
 mine. - Now all went in d. house to dance & sweat.  
 Eel had a young daughter & he put sticks in her ears  
 and said now will dance. They danced & sweat men all  
 went & sweat, men all slept. Now a little bird, went  
 out he heard people outside then he told the people <sup>inside</sup>  
 there is somebody outside. Now they ran after him  
 but he got away - Now early morning Eel went to see his  
 trap he had caught lots of fish & he said now go dig roots  
 will all go & camp out & dig roots the women said  
 its too far to come home first night. Chief said perhaps  
 roots not ripe yet, always keep on the watch  
 bad people come around that like to kill our people

Old Flint said I dont care for anybody if they come  
I'll fight them when I was a young man I was  
very strong & was never afraid I always fought, but  
I'm a very old man now. - Now young men & women  
started off to camp out & dig. Chief said you young  
men keep watch all the time. I had lots of people long  
time ago but the winter, southern people came & killed  
off many of my people. when I tell you you dont  
believe, but you watch out or you will not come back  
Old Bear men & old Fish men, & wood doves, all  
the old men & women staid home, they started and came  
to a little valley other side of Oak Valley & stopped  
and dug all kinds of roots & gathered clover. - They  
Camped other side of Oak-Run in a little valley, and they  
looked & ate, night came. they talked & laughed. And  
now western people came around near them, and listened  
Some of them wanted to kill them but others said no let them  
go they will come back again to - <sup>young</sup> ~~old~~ man  
Flint's son, was boss for these campers and he said  
to-morrow let us camp here again, my father said  
it was a bad place down west, below here, - Next morning  
a young man saw lots of people off in the west, and  
Young Flint said I want you to go back home  
and tell the old people to come these western  
people will fight us, He sent wood dove. - He got  
there. said young Flint wants you to come, people  
last night saw us & act as if they wanted to  
kill us. all right that is what we told you - Bear  
said you dont believe when we old people told you  
you call yourself men. Old Flint said dont let  
that way will go or our young people will get killed  
Old Bear said I'd like to go. Chief said I want you all

to go the sun is high - Now all the old fellows  
start. Flint was one of the chief & he went with all  
the others but old Eel stay home, he was blind,  
about sundown they got to the camp, women cooked  
and all ate. Old people said we told you there were bad  
Indians off west here. Now they slept, some kept watch  
and soon they saw other Indians prowling around  
& they all got up & watched didnt sleep much. There  
were lots of roots, a big flat, and old Flint said go there  
& dig to-morrow. Pan-i-tau-na = root place. was the name  
of the flat. Chief said always the South & West Indians  
always used to come here & fight me when long time  
ago we dug roots here. - The women started out next  
morning & dug roots around, & the men went to creek  
& caught salmon & built fire & cooked them, he was  
watching the fire, and the people saw the smoke of  
the fire. They went around east so as to watch.  
Now the man looked off east & saw lots of people  
coming down from the east, it was wood down  
who built the fire & he called out to the others  
Come up & get your bows & arrows we shall have  
to fight. Now the people came down upon them  
they were all southern people Wintus. Yawe

These who were catching salmon threw  
down nets. New lines began to fight

Young Flint said I want you to go on and fight  
those people want to kill us. These people are like

my <sup>two</sup> ~~body~~ I am not going to be afraid. I took  
out arrows and put them in my mouth to  
shoot. I had a lumi also. (The Yawu who

were coming were Sabuk<sup>hair</sup>eyen, Pare<sup>rain</sup>no  
Hchwitca<sup>fine rain</sup> Walaya<sup>dog</sup>, Tahay<sup>in</sup>kasi with pan<sup>pan</sup>hji

These Yawu began to fight. - The Nosas  
were Haka. Mudyampa. Tenna, T<sup>antear</sup>ripal<sup>antear</sup>  
Nunuyantear, Sakalantear, <sup>ping</sup>Wuna<sup>mets</sup>

yaptaiwa, <sup>crane</sup> ~~Kurida~~ = I sorato, <sup>Yellowham</sup> Tula =  
<sup>w dove</sup> Maibya. Now I want you to fight these  
 people ~~and~~ Haka. Then looking he said to  
 Rain I know you. <sup>They</sup> fought on ~~the~~ both sides  
 but Noras not hurt Wuntus suffer more  
 Flint killed four or five at a shot. Still  
~~the~~ Wuntus drove the Noras toward their camp  
 Flint send to Rancher for the old men to help  
 a young doctor went followed when near Ranch  
 and saw me want you old people to  
 come quick. Old people all come, bears  
 in full number. Wuntus all the time pressing  
 on Rain & Hail lose heavily but still press on  
 The great ~~hail~~ Hail knock down the Noras with  
 loss till Sabilkeya Mudiampa called to his people  
 to halt. The bears effect great destruction among  
 the Wuntus killing at every shot. Wuntus  
 press on toward camp and when near they  
 kill young Tiriakala - Flint said to  
 his people you hide don't fight here. They said  
 we don't want to hide we want to fight.  
 Tiriakala says I think I shall eat no  
 more I'm going to die now too I've  
 lost my son. I want you young people  
 to fight well I lost my best boy. When  
 Noras shoot they kill many but still  
 the Wuntus come they are so many in  
 number. Tiriakala says I don't think any of  
 us will return <sup>home</sup> well all got killed  
 a long time ago when we dug roots here  
 we always fought at this place  
 I thought we not going to fight anymore  
 and as he spoke he cried, but now

Well fight with you now said the  
Wintuns. Now all the Nosa women  
cry over the fate of Young Tuskal

Now the fight rages the bear destroy  
many Wintuns great slaughter on both  
sides till at last W<sup>o</sup> tired and  
cried let stop now and fight tomorrow

We always begin to fight but great  
many of us get killed. ~~The~~

Both sides stopped but none cared  
for the dead lying around in heaps.

The Wintuns went home that night.

The Noses carried home Young Tuskala &  
buried at Salt Coast Creek = Witemina =

(Witem = salt) Old Tusk said were lost the  
best young men we had but the W<sup>o</sup> will

come tomorrow. The W<sup>o</sup> are so numerous  
they never stop. Next morning women went

west to dig roots. One man saw <sup>the</sup> W<sup>o</sup> on the watch  
if you see the W<sup>o</sup> throw down baskets & run

Some of the men went to watch with <sup>the</sup> women

About middle of noon clouds appeared

and the W<sup>o</sup> came from the East side and went  
to where women to get their roots. Men on watch

cry Yawi coming Y coming, Women scream  
surrounded running hither & thither. W<sup>o</sup> steal the

young women kill the old. Some Nosa hurried  
home for help and returned by the West thus

flanking them. Haka says to W<sup>o</sup> be slow  
with my people you can't steal them I'll take

them away. The W<sup>o</sup> now let all the  
prisoners go which they had taken. I guess

well have a big fight to-day. They fought hard  
the W<sup>o</sup> go towards home N<sup>o</sup> follow and kill many

W<sup>o</sup>. many N<sup>o</sup> killed among the number the Dove



Dove's brother says I lost my brother now  
I fight. Fight all day to the armies  
At Pateaimana = Manzanita place, a foggy  
hilled. We thought retreating till many of the  
No. battle strong. Middle P.M. Nosa Indians  
said lets quit to-day, will fight again to-morrow. Both  
sides now rested. didnt shoot any more. Nosa's went  
to their camp right there. Wintu had stolen 2 women  
during the day. The Nosa's didnt pick up their dead  
didnt bury them any more let them go. They said we  
must call more people to help us. All the women  
cried ~~men~~ <sup>women</sup> wouldnt cry. Next morning the Nosa chief  
sent ~~east~~ <sup>west</sup> yellow hammer, & red winged blackbird  
went <sup>west</sup> below, (south) said will call another tribe to help us  
People at Oak Run came Bears, Trainers, others &  
went to Cow Creek & got others. They all came. Now  
all the people came together, that were to assist the Nosa's  
met <sup>just</sup> below Buzzard's Roost. Black Bear & all kinds of  
people. The old man Flint said my people are all  
dead now I guess I'll die too. Next morning all started  
out to fight. They said to women look out perhaps the  
Wintus will come right here while we are away.  
They started west & then south towards Redding  
found the Wintu ~~see~~ Indians camped on Sacramento  
River at Redding, lots of them they were dancing  
The Nosa's crept up & saw the Wintus pulling and  
the 2 Nosa women & dancing with them - it was  
myst. Dove watched the people saw the 2 women  
hurry down his head and cried. Then he went back  
where he left the body of Nosa's & said I've seen the  
two girls. They were two Flint girls. Dove said lets  
go & kill these people. When daylight came they  
moved up a little nearer and surrounded the  
Wintus and they fell upon the Wintu camp  
Wintus terribly frightened all got up. Wren

one of the Wintus said now let us fight, We both  
Nose Asa Indians that is why they come here to  
fight, we keep the chiefs daughter that is why he  
is so mad. Now all began to shoot. Now Nasas  
would kill 2, 3, 4, Wintu at a shot, the children  
all screamed, all day they fought, Mutton Yellow  
with an elk skin blanket on, a Wintu fought her  
and when he shot he reached his head way out  
his blanket stretched his neck out long, then  
as soon as he shot he would draw his head down  
in his elk skin blanket, they fought till noon  
not one Nasas got killed but lots of Wintu got killed  
they took back their 2 women & stole 2 Wintu  
women said now we'll have a dance - some of  
the Wintu escaped, ran off, and they now call  
more Indians to help them, and they followed the  
Nasas, the Nasas came back towards home, dancing  
every time they stopped traveling & the chief old Flint  
said now watch out those people will follow us.  
They got as far as Millville when they saw people  
coming, they were Wintus, came down upon them, lots  
of them - Old Flint said let the A. W. women go these people  
will kill us, another said no I want to take them home  
Wintu surrounded the A's - the two captives were screaming  
they had a great battle now. Lots of Wintu got killed right  
there, they said give us back the 2 women - we'll fight no  
more. N. said when you took our w. you wouldn't  
give them back. all right if you want to fight every  
day will fight. & again they fought. Nasas said this is  
our place here, you must go. you watch us every day  
always ready to fight, all right will eat no more but  
fight all the time. Old Flint said if you want to kill me do  
it right here - Wintu said if you men enough you  
kill me - Noon came & they rested - Lots of Wintu got  
killed, & they went back south. The Nasas took along  
their captives not one of the A's had been killed and  
they went home & danced & pulled around the 2 women

as they danced. - Chief said perhaps people will come  
again to night. Some people kept watch. Nobody came.  
Captain Chief told people to get up & rush. Perhaps Wintu  
would come again that day. (Y-u-che Sunday). All staid home  
that day played grass games. Middle P. M. they began to  
dance with the captives just as Wintu danced with their  
Captive rosa women. - Young yellow hammer wanted to go  
out & hunt. and Flint said you go towards the East not  
South or West. Boy went saw in gulches Wintu Indians  
Boy screamed he was so frightened & ran home & said another  
people are coming to kill us. The men took their bows  
& arrows & got ready to fight. Chief F. said I told you  
they would come, this is the way long time ago these here  
came every day. The Wintu came up near the camp  
& began to shoot. Lots of women & men got killed.  
Chief <sup>of Wintu</sup> said you come to my place to fight me now I  
set even on you. Now the ~~two~~ No's tried to surround  
the W's. Lots got killed. Old Chief Yellow Hammer  
got killed old Blackbird got killed. and little  
black bird got shot many times in his breast  
& died & young Flint got killed "is dead now"  
Ara's said lets stop not fight any more. I want  
to catch salmon & dig roots. - Wintu said no we want  
stop will fight. No. said very well if you like  
to fight we will kill you all - Now No's received  
new ~~some~~ tribes - and they kept fighting, now  
they were at Millville old Chief Flint was <sup>killed</sup>  
and a strong man Common Bear. Now it  
was mid afternoon & the W's said well stop  
it is time for us to go to our camp. Wintu captured  
two ~~Nos~~ sons of old Flint. They broken their  
legs by shooting and couldn't run. - Nos's came  
off back home. They had lots of white feathers on  
hats, now all cried. Daylight came. and they  
said will call more people. and will go South  
& kill the Wintu's. We have lots more people up north

One son of Old Flint was left - He said yes will  
go & kill them. They have stolen my brothers. Now  
some of the people had frightened. Now below Buffards  
Roost was a whole tribe of Flint people. Now the A.S.  
fixed a new ranch at Oak Run. and they said let  
us rest a little while not start out too quick - Now  
all the people came to Oak Run, all the Flint & every  
to help the A.S. Old <sup>blind chief</sup> Eel said I'll fix up a  
mound for the dead people. but others said no let  
them stay as they are. and Eel said now fix heads  
on your arrows & will kill the winter. Eel was an  
"awful big chief & called all the A.S. sons" - ~~now~~  
Now Eel sent for Water dog and other both big chiefs  
of other tribes to come help him and he sent for Mountain  
Dove & Jaybird to come. all came. That night they  
all had a big dance war dance. 2 days danced. Some  
played grass game. Next morning they started off to fight  
Went off towards Redding. Got down to this side of  
Woodman's at Little Round Mountain & took a camp.  
and the chief sent out men to see if there was any  
one around. he sent out Jaybird. Young Flint was  
now chief one of the Buffard Roost Flint. Jaybird  
makes too much noise some said sent Yellow Hammer  
he knows the winter place. Y. H. said all right.  
Jaybird said I'll go too. now they started J. B. went  
south side Y. H. went north side of the camp.  
They looked everywhere to see a smoke. Jaybird  
saw a big ranch not far below Woodman's over a  
hill and a great many W. were playing grass game.  
Now Y. H. & Jaybird came back. to a place they had  
agreed to meet at. Y. H. got there first and as Jaybird  
came up he screamed Ye-yi. Ye-yi - "I see & I see"  
(lots of people). Y. H. said Keep still. A.S. <sup>heard him</sup>  
came up & they all stood up & waited for him  
he said I saw lots of winter, too many  
Indians.

Y. H. said I saw nobody, perhaps G. bird did. I looked  
all over I ~~guess~~ saw nobody - G. bird said I saw  
too many people on cant kill them all. - Now all the  
No's started for the W. Camp about noon. Said  
will go to the spring and camp & rest men start out by  
sundown. They did so. - Chief said we must watch out  
Near Sundown they started, got near hid themselves  
in the brush. - Now they sent out 3 spies - Y. H. Blue Jay  
& Flint boy - saw lots of people. Salmon said and  
Duckers. Fish of all kind were in the Wintu Camp. - The  
3 boys went back to No. Said we shant come back. Those  
people are too many. Great many young men. - The N.  
Chief said what shall we do. Some said we must not attack  
them, others said we dont want to go home let us go on  
Otter said I came here to kill these people I'll not go  
home. Chief said very well. Chief said no more when  
Otter latter this way. - They started. went around W. camp  
during the night - Daylight came. - Old Man ~~fish~~  
Ducker a Wintu heard somebody around & he called  
out get up. Wintu some people are around us to kill  
us. I guess it is Otter & his people & Black Bear  
& Flint people, I called all these people Cousin  
but they have come to try & kill us. Everybody  
got up look bow & arrow. - Asas came upon them  
suddenly stole their children & baskets, Wintu men  
brightened & dropped bows & arrows & run away  
& As to run after them. Killed many. Flint was  
mad. and he killed many. Otter killed many. & they  
stole lots of things from the W. Camp. and brought them  
home. Cinnamon Bear. had a Wintu woman, that's  
what's the matter. & he stayed with Wintus. & Asas stole  
his children & he came up to Oak Run & said my  
brothers I want my children - B. Bear said why dont  
you come home & stay not stay with Wintus - Will

I like my Chaco wife - They gave him back his children  
Young Flint got home first to ranch told women to get  
out & dance for we are bringing out home lots of captives.  
Wintus all run & we captured their children - now it,  
women all danced. - All came driving children front of  
them. Nosa women kept dancing - men coming & screamed  
& made great noise - when they saw children women took  
up dirt & threw in their faces. Now men began to dance  
when about 100 yards away from ranch here & made the  
captives dance. Children cried, and they caught them  
& twisted their necks because they cried nearly broke  
their necks - Chief said now we want "grub" women  
cooked all kinds of Indian food. All ate, then slept  
middle of night 3 captives got away, then somebody  
woke up, saw me 3 gone, and he woke up people. -  
Everybody hunted all around took torch, couldnt find them  
I say first came they tracked them, saw they went  
south, they followed. They went off one side, came to  
River & saw where boys went. - They caught one boy. <sup>held</sup>  
him, put the body under a lot of stones - The other two boys  
got home - Nosa went back home, felt bad because boys got  
away. Flint at B. Rust Roost said I want to go home - Old  
Eel said no I want you to stay a little with me & I'll feed  
you. I'm going down to steal more Wintus I wouldnt do  
it but they bother me first. Middle of day they saw something  
coming. - He said what shall we do, Eel said make arrows  
our arrows are nearly gone, they all went to work on arrows  
Eel said I wish you come yourself bows & arrows. ask  
said it lots of bows & arrows came there, piles of them.  
Made quivers out of wild cat skins & Fox skins, &  
other skin come. Old Eel called them up, and the quivers  
were full of arrows. - Eel said cut for me sharp brush  
I'm going to make canes of of it. He made a cane  
and he took it and swung it around in his hands  
and lots of arrows all with flint heads came. Now  
he told the tribes that were there to help him, go home  
perhaps these here will kill you because they

bind you here with me. - Fish and suckers  
& such people went home, they were half & road half  
winter & helped both sides. Near sundown somebody  
screamed off East. Wintus were coming down onto the  
Noses again. - Flint said now be careful. W<sup>o</sup> Army

They met at Morley's <sup>valley</sup> Oak Run little valley  
= Jawie'mina battle fight story. !!!

Go on he trace fight in the day I don't  
want these people coming at night.

Wintus crowd on so many of em. I heard I acted  
who brought dead to line on battle field and  
the W<sup>o</sup> put to flight. they followed Wintus  
again turn & kill game & later still retreat  
to Teina inawawi. ~~or~~ Dry Oak house <sup>relaxed</sup>

W<sup>o</sup> cry out despite for drink. then well fight  
till sundown all night saw Nos. The drink  
Nos Chief said I thought you be friends but  
you always ~~love~~ <sup>say</sup> me W<sup>o</sup>. You always steal  
my children trouble me. After drink Nos  
try to flank W<sup>o</sup> and W<sup>o</sup> call for stoppage  
of fight but N<sup>o</sup> kill ~~W<sup>o</sup>~~ all but who  
escaped Hohwitina and (Issanewa) <sup>want</sup>

Battle over N<sup>o</sup> returns to camp. ~~and next day~~  
go to rancheria. first night of people cry all  
night. none sleep. <sup>Flint</sup> I stand with the  
~~at~~ camp yet. <sup>hope to get more</sup> Flint not satisfied with  
the continual war tired of it. X

Next morning after camp people want home  
Torusk ~~does~~ don't agree wants to fight. Says  
to people I want you to stay <sup>here</sup> not go off  
people yet in camp. No dance all

month my wanting Torusk wants for war.  
prepare Haka Haka undyampa scolds  
Torusk for send y<sup>e</sup> people west for roots said  
of the new found East all would be

and wants them in future to stay home  
 lots more W<sup>o</sup>. Next morning went to another  
 Camp near Oak <sup>Badjet</sup> Pateltogue and for  
 sunflower seed wild grapes etc. Stayed  
 in camp & got all kinds of fresh & dried  
 there.

Had a house <sup>at the</sup> head of Oak Run <sup>creek</sup> had a house up there  
<sup>on a</sup> <sup>top</sup> mountain. and B. Bear had a sister <sup>Cinnamon</sup> <sup>Root</sup>  
 she had one <sup>two</sup> <sup>daughters</sup> <sup>but</sup> <sup>her</sup> <sup>husband</sup> <sup>was</sup> <sup>dead</sup>  
 in one house. B. Bear said to <sup>the</sup> <sup>girl</sup> <sup>to</sup> <sup>marry</sup> <sup>you</sup> <sup>to</sup> <sup>gather</sup> <sup>manzanilla</sup> <sup>berries</sup>  
 the girl said <sup>the</sup> <sup>fruit</sup> <sup>is</sup> <sup>not</sup> <sup>ripe</sup> <sup>yet</sup> <sup>it</sup> <sup>is</sup> <sup>winter</sup> <sup>yet</sup>. <sup>the</sup> <sup>man</sup> <sup>said</sup>

you must feed him to night - girls laughed when

they wont talk with us. Hummingbird went off  
for other Bears. by the way A. Bird went to

L's house when L. saw him he took out his  
knife to kill him but. A. said dont do that  
my Brother - L. said what do you want - I came  
to tell you that G. B's want to play games with  
you. <sup>L. said I guess I'll buy Bears for their men I've killed</sup>  
Hunting Bird went home. went in told Bears what  
L. said. B. said where will we meet, over in the little  
valley here. B. said to H. G. it is noon now go & tell  
L. - He got there told L. I want you to go to the little  
valley over here. go quick - L. all went to valley  
They carried arrows, <sup>sewa</sup> baskets &  $\frac{e}{n}$  and hona-pine  
nuts, and deer hides. Bears came there. B's cried  
old B. said I'm afraid - L. said dont be afraid.  
L. said I will pay me & I'll pay you. you began  
first to kill my people - now B. was mad again &  
refused to pay & they began to fight. but Big L.  
stopped them & said I dont want to fight any more  
now all the B's sat down - B. said Bear hide & deer  
hides. and L. said B's baskets & arrows - now all  
cried - Old B. said I'll not bathe you any more  
you can go out to dig roots & kill deer when you  
like. and L. said I'll not bathe you & some  
parties went home. didnt fight anymore, & bear  
came up north & got <sup>to</sup> manganeta. and people killed  
Bear. Eagle & Buzzard. & Chicken Hawk lined up  
north and they killed him. <sup>& camp out</sup> Young Buzzard saw  
fight.  
Bear coming up saw his camp fire &  
told Eagle. Chathen hawk & others that B  
was coming. he saw I know its Bear Eagle  
says yes, Eagle lets eat and then go out after  
him. Eagle says I know that man he's had  
I dont like to have him come here, lets go to  
the West and get around him. B. the bear

went to sleep slept sound. Eagles people  
Came close to bear camp and I saw as soon  
as daylight well go and tell those people  
At daylight the bears were surrounded the  
little bear woke up first and said people  
Coming. Eagle went to work crushed bear's  
heads in with his first hand took out the  
brains. ~~just~~ <sup>only</sup> ~~one~~ bear escaped and 3  
little ones. The 14 bears cried all the  
way home. The Eagle's house was at Paeth  
home = Sirimangapi = Raven's Drunken  
place. They ~~the~~ carried off three little  
bear girls and one boy. They ran home quickly  
and threw down roughly the children  
then the Eagle people danced very  
beautifully. At night Eagle tried  
and I said let's sleep. Well dance  
tomorrow. They danced next day. <sup>Wongkijun</sup> Otter  
Salmons & <sup>Dani</sup> <sup>Dyampilwila</sup> Duckers came & danced  
also Hatenna = water grizzly. Danced and  
took the bear girls and boy. The dance  
Eagle says I'll give you these children  
you take em home tomorrow  
Hatenna glad to get em & said Delight  
come quick it came. Eagle <sup>says</sup> I want  
you to feed these little fellows lots of fruit  
Hatenna says I want to go home quick  
while cool in morning. Eagle kept  
one girl boy, take me home don't be afraid. - Pwittakai  
little water bird, he belonged to the water bear people. Eagle  
told Otter not to be afraid of that man, look them down to  
Mildgammaunee. (all women's race place) name of which  
now, that was Otter's home. Next morning he went out  
to call Indians to come. They came. He said I'd like to  
let Pwittakai know but maybe he mad and won't come

If you like send + let him come. people said, they said  
 he came about noon. He acted very mad when he  
 saw the 2 children. E. said I'll send for more people  
 perhaps he'll fight me I know he is mad. Now  
 little fly - Djogmit's aina, was one of Eagle's men  
 and he sent him out and told him to tell people  
 to come quick - He ran fast. and told men to come  
 quick said little bird is mad and wants to take  
 the children away - Now and Eagle's Chuker being  
 all went. got to Eagle's place - there were a lot of  
 people with little bird, and they all acted very mad.  
 Now Water-day Bear he came there + he held the  
 children close the children cried afraid, Bird said  
 you stole my people's children, Water-day said if  
 you are man get these children away from me, yes  
 I am a man I whipped men long time ago, - Now  
 E. said stop don't fight I want to dance not fight  
 now they some began to dance, now some began to fight  
 Otter fought with Duckee they were old enemies  
 had stolen each other's wives. Otter said I want to kill  
 these 2 girls. Hatinna said all right I don't want to  
 keep men + about noon they killed the 2 girls. Hatinna  
 said to little bird now if you see a man fight with  
 me, at least all started off home. Little bird went  
 north. came to Bear's house and told them that they  
 had killed the 2 girls, and only one boy is left. Now  
 Bear people all cried.

Mipaka = Crane. had a sweat house where  
 Jack's S.H. Igdalmatu = Bone place - He  
 says I don't know what skin going to do  
 I must think about, and then he cut  
 his leg with hatchet - small piece of  
 black flint. After he cut it in several  
 place and blood flowed he gathered it in  
 a cup = Tarkila = basket cup then cut

both ~~arms~~. from ~~the~~ each leg he got two  
Tentilla's of blood & from each arm the  
same amount <sup>each</sup> of cups in all. Then he  
went to get wood and made fire heated  
rocks, then got manaima (dried bird's  
placed it there. Then told people I don't  
want you around get away. put rocks  
hot ones in the bucket, water boiled up & he covered it over  
with another basket. bucket shook the water boiled so fast  
then he put the blood into the bucket. Now he stood there  
& watched the bucket. after an hour the bucket just  
like burst. and El-hatina came out of it and flew  
up to the sky. Crane said now when you come out  
and go up to the sky you stay there. he said this when  
he put his blood in the bucket - now when El-hatina  
came out. he went to the basket, nothing in it now  
turned it over & said if you like I want you to  
come back right under my arm but don't open your  
eye when you come, come under my arm & nobody  
will see you. now Thunder came back & sat  
down on Crane's knee, and he looked like an awful  
old fellow. had an old rabbit skin blanket on. Crane  
made Thunder to look old. he said if you go out & wander  
around perhaps you'll kill everybody. when I like  
to go somewhere I'm going to carry you right under my  
arm - El-hatina laughed ha! ha! (Thunder looked right  
& old. no hair bald headed. as though he had shaved

with Rabbit woman, she missed (R woman) R. woman  
sat on both side - Sleep woman had 10 sticks and  
put in the centre. Sleep woman beat Rabbit w.  
and then she told Silk woman now play. (She just  
told R. woman to sit one side) and she said to R. woman  
I thought you were a good player I was told so.  
Now S. woman said I don't want a woman to beat me  
I know you'll beat me for you are three to one  
I know I should beat that Rabbit woman - Thunder  
now had come and sat down looking on ready  
to play & he said I don't know why I of no play against  
me - S. woman said she is a bad woman maybe  
pretty soon she will make us all go to sleep that  
is the way she does to kill people. Thunder said  
play quick I don't want to wait so long - Now  
J. Silk woman beat Sleep woman about middle of  
afternoon. Hold on now Sleep woman said I want  
to eat a little & rest, there is more daylight yet.  
C. woman said I know you, how you talk. you are  
going to do something bad - W. said no I talk right  
I'm tired I want to rest & eat. Night came right then  
Sleep woman made it so, and instantly all the people  
fell asleep except S. woman. She couldn't get him to sleep.  
Now S. woman kept her eye on S. woman all night she  
said you are a strong man if you don't sleep to night  
Thunder didn't sleep and he laughed pff pff - now  
all night the 8 kept awake till morning came, all

to go. - Now Jupta told Thunder to come & sit down  
by his side but W. said I dont want anybody to see  
me. Woman said it looks as if you cheated me.  
Dont you talk to me that way Jupta said. When  
it was near night, neither had ever J. said I want  
to quit a while. Sleep W. said I guess you are going  
to do something wrong to me that is why you talk that  
way. Now that moment all the people fell asleep  
though it was bright daylight yet. Now Thunder  
was mad & said what makes that woman do that  
way I'll open my eyes. That moment he opened  
his eyes & all the people were killed burned up.  
Thunder said if you werent mapeaminca youll  
get burned up now. but she did burn. got killed  
Now it was night Thunder shut his eyes now

even all day. Now J. took out his smooth rock sticks  
middle afternoon J. said I want you to open your  
legs a little. Now J. held the rocks. and the woman  
rock flew at the woman & went into her & split  
her right open. killed her. Now they rolled up the woman  
up in deer hide & put her in the ground & many of the  
people cried. Jupta said pretty good I killed the woman  
she always gave us bad sleep. made us go to sleep.  
Now Crane said <sup>sent his son</sup> <sup>want</sup> after Cedar people <sup>Creek</sup>



to come go hunt with us young Crane told  
Silver 7. I guess you tired of eating pine nuts &  
salmon my father wants you to eat deer meat.  
Now all 8. Fox's people went up to Crane's sweat house  
next morning they started out & one man went ahead  
& built a fire near Holemba's place all the people  
came up. C. stood in the middle by the fire. 8. Fox  
was mad because Sleep woman was killed, and he came  
into the center & talked to Crane, you think you are  
a man and you allow this thing & 8. Fox took hold of  
him & watched him one side. C. said yes I'm a man  
let me alone, which way are you going to hit me  
with your knife I'm nothing but bones, my body. Now  
all began to fight. Wolf said I don't want you people  
to fight I came here to kill deer. Wolf was with Silver  
Fox and he told Crane why do you always try to kill  
people I thought you were a great chief - now all stopped  
fighting but they wouldn't hunt all went home. Now  
when they got home Thunder said this is enough, this  
will do, you people won't see me any more. he was mad  
because the people fought. Now 7. opened his eyes, quick  
& shut them quick said I don't like to stay around here in  
the place you fellows brought all the time. And he started  
and came down to Cedar Creek packing his rabbit blankets.  
Lots of people there. now the young girls said why men  
comes that little ugly old man coming down the trail  
Thunder heard them & said hum! hum! I'd like to have  
one of these girls. (these were wolf's girls) - Oh that  
ugly old man wants to get a wife and old woman  
Wolf laughed, I don't think you'll get my girls - Thunder  
said to Wolf I like your girl but you don't believe me  
& he opened his eyes & all the people were dead, now  
he went down the creek in the trail till he came

to Djidjirha, on Cow Creek where there was a big  
rancher there in a little valley Buffard & Fox and  
Medcat & Coon lived there. Chiefs of a great number  
of people. Lots of young girls at play outside when they  
saw Y. coming they said why does that little old fellow  
come down this way he's too old to travel. Y. could  
always hear & he said hum! I would like to catch one  
of your girls, there were Medcat's & hawk's girls & Buffard  
& Coon's girls. Children all ran to his house. Y. then he  
went up to the A. T. and said I'd like to have one of  
these girls, and he had on his old dirty blanket, "awful  
nasty blanket". He told Coon's wife I'd like to have  
one of your girls. What makes you like girls you are  
too old. <sup>roughly</sup> girls father said. Now Y. spread his eye quick &  
killed everybody. (It seems Y. didn't kill his own people at  
Caracas before he started) Y. went on came to White  
Hite's place - wild cat place - Here wild cats &  
Fox's had a great rancher. People saw Y. when he

old fellow coming. What makes that old fellow travel  
he is too old - Y. laughed pfu pfu pfu - and he came

"people dead too quick" - Came on below on Cow Creek  
to another rancher. Coyote lived there & Fox & Coon & Chick  
Hawk & owl. People saw old man coming & talked as before  
Y. asked for one of the girls. They said you too ugly. Opened his eye  
killed all. This side of Woodmen's big rancher. Little black  
bird DiKitei and Crow lived there too, (they are  
wink now more people). They said we have never seen  
such an ugly old ~~thing~~ man this is the first time we have  
ever seen him. Chief Blackbird said I know that man  
he is a bad man I know he kills off people. One said  
oh what can he kill anyone with he has no bow  
& arrow you not afraid. Chief said if you talk to

I'll run away, and then you people can talk to  
him & Blackbird run off. I was a long way off  
yet, but black bird knew quick now all the  
girls ran to the house afraid. I saw them run & he  
went after them. said pfe pfe I dont know why  
people all set this way to me. I dont like it. Give  
me one of these girls. One man said no you are too  
ugly. then he opened his eyes & killed everybody &  
he started off quick. went on till he came to Woodman's  
place. lots of people below Woodman's. I got most  
men. Crane & geese & bussard & white geese. lived here  
& wild dove. he got near. one man knew quick  
(It was blackbird who had gone over from the other ranch  
and he said I know that man but my people wouldnt  
believe me. Why dont you people run away. - They wouldnt  
believe & run away. I said the same. Pigeon said lets  
give him a girl. people said what can he do with a girl.  
I laughed said pfe pfe & he opened his eye & killed everybody  
then he went on. came to another ranch, threw away his  
blanket & stood up, a young handsome man, it  
was nothing but geese & black & white both, &  
Ducks. <sup>pupila</sup> nothing else. & he stood up & was a handsome  
young fellow as soon as he threw off his blanket.  
and he said the people all call me bad names  
& I have killed them all but you people dont call  
me bad names I'll not kill you I dont like to meet  
on the ground & he sat down that moment night.  
Came & he said I with Cloud would come quick.  
& <sup>Clouds came</sup> middle of night big rain fall. and there was  
a noise like a great Cannon terrible noise & the

Wood dove had a house at Blaw Creek his people had all been killed off by grizzly bear. Two little boys ~~were~~ all rest killed off Bears said they too little & ugly they'd die anyhow when its cold. - Everyday the bears would come to see if the boys were going. Both laid right up in the ashes of the dead fire. Bears said we would go to ~~see~~ anywhere they don't grow any they are ~~dead~~ dead. - That night the 2 little boys moved off a little from the O. house & the eldest one sat up now and he smoothed down his hair, looked around, nobody there - he went into a. h. all empty but the boys' bows & arrows hanging up around, he stood up & looked around & said I don't know where all my people have gone, & he said to youngest boy get up & look around. Eldest said I'd like to have a little fire. I wish fire would come & he took some dry grass & gathered it in a little lump and he said I wish gun would come fire light here in the center of this ground & it came & he said to brother get up & we will ~~burn~~ ~~at~~ he said pull me up. Then Eldest brother did & little one said keep hold of me or I shall fall & he did on together they danced around. - They said I don't know where my own people have gone that they don't come & sweat, sweat came & they heard a big noise outside O. h. & bear came in to see the boys & he said who has built a fire here. Youngest boy had a little large flint-knife & the other b. had one. Eldest said to B. who told to come to this O. h. Nobody told me this is my house bear said. and he opened his mouth & swallowed the two boys. The eldest cut his heart & he died & the two boys came out. - B. was dead, eldest b. gathered up grass, and they said will dance & sweat. They threw the B. out. Soon another B. came and he said same & boys did the same. Killed B. said now I guess that's what you want. - Y. b. said build a big fire I want to sweat & grow fast.

little boy said I guess these people killed off all  
our people - Next morning the 2 boys started off west-  
got below Oak Run. to a little mountain & set down  
& rested. They had both grown fast. - They looked down  
south & saw a big Rancher. said I don't know why we  
came here there are too many people perhaps they will kill  
us youngest b. said I'm not afraid they won't kill us.  
Eldersaid I'm afraid I'm not strong enough to fight  
more people - y. b. said I'm going to stand up here  
perhaps some people will see me - He took a smooth  
rock & put all over his body & head. & stood up.  
Now people looked up towards the summit of the hill  
they had been playing shooting & running races. They saw  
boys & said looks as though somebody was standing  
up there one said that is an old stump it has always been  
there is this first time you saw it - Yes you never saw  
stump there that is a person lets shoot, if wrong fly back  
is one man. all looked they shot hit but arrow  
came back - Yes that is no man it is a stump - So  
they let it go - Chief Gosee was chief of this place.  
ducks & all kind of water birds Chief said it is night  
stop hunting & come in at - Malard duck said hum! I  
smell Done. Nune. <sup>wood done is pinenuise</sup> Goose said  
I don't think they will come all his people is killed off  
Some man said 2 little ones were left perhaps  
they didn't die - Now all the people went in. Some  
women slept outside - Now done came that night  
up to a. h. looked at it at top, and then he went back - People  
said I hear a noise like doves talking said Malard  
Duck - Chief said no it is the children outside. No all  
are asleep, now they sent one man out - Doves had gone  
back to mountain (perhaps a mile away) Long time  
before they had killed the people & had brought one of the  
men here & had hung him up over the smoke hole. - Done  
said to eldest b. I saw my people inside there. y. said  
I will take him away when our people sleep. Elders  
b. said there are too many of them people perhaps they will

Now the 2 came + set down near s. house. Now  
all came out s. h. mountain creek to swim - then each went to  
own house. Dove said now lets look in s. h. - He put his  
hands in felt Doves head + body + he said this is my sample  
both sat top of s. h. + cried. y. b. said take off right hand  
I will left hand, (he was tied) they died + pulled him up by s. h.  
carried him off a little. put him down, y. b. said stay a little  
I'll cut a stick - he did, they pulled him up + didnt dove  
they rapped him all over from head to foot then laid him down  
the with the stick, then he rubbed him + took off all the hide  
then he went to creek + got water. poured it all over his body. +  
then set him up. held his hand against his stomach - Little boy  
said why do sleep so long you are no man - Now he stood  
up. man said dont go fast, and eldest b. packed him - He said  
dont go on the trail. they got to below creek. the same way they came  
they got home. y. b. said hurry up now or the bears will  
come. they saw somebody coming + they ran off east, got on  
top mountain + the 3 boys sat down kept looking back to  
see which way B. would come - B. was smelling ground  
to see which way they had gone. Boys ran again. they followed  
a creek now going up (Rock creek). they ran to the east  
as fast as they could. heard B. coming behind calling as he  
ran. Dove said I want Bear to run slow. and so it was  
B. couldnt run so fast, but he got nearly up to the boys +  
they had to sit down to rest. Now there was a rock there  
+ Dove said I want you to go up high quick. B.  
came to Rock reached up to pull boys down but it was  
already too high. Now B. tried to bite off rock with his  
teeth had the rock nearly bitten off when he died, broke  
all his teeth out + then he fell down dead. + now the  
boys told rock to go down + they got off + cut off the B.  
Jack has seen the rock + it is a nice smooth rock  
higher than a persons head, and it is nearly cut in two.  
Bear did it. Now a mother bear came on the trail  
following the boys. Dove said you cant kill me + show this  
rock. he killed second + 3rd bear same way. There were  
four rocks and he killed a bear on each rock + he  
loved to cut meat + each time when he had the rock +  
he died

now boys went home. got most there looked  
at his O. H. saw lots of keepe around there. Geese  
was after them now owls, Malard Ducks, Crows  
Wildeats for all kinds of people had come from Jovias  
ranch here to kill Doves - Eldest b. said I guess we shall be  
killed now. - Y. b. said I'm man enough for them. One  
made you alive again I am stronger than these people.  
Eldest b. said I dont like to go to the O. H. too many people.  
Y. b. said will hide awhile & watch perhaps they will go home.  
Lundown they were near O. house - Eldest b. said they have all  
gone, now the brothers went to O. H. & built big fire & heated  
rocks. and the Y. b. hunted for a bucket, rocks hot. It was  
middle of night now Y. b. said to 2 men brothers, hide yourself  
& want to do something. He closed up the smoke hole all  
was dark in O. H. he went to break got bucket of water, but  
top O. H. then took the hot rocks outside & put them in  
the bucket: then he cut a stick & then he went all around the  
O. H. striking it all around - now the water boiled & the boys  
went in & hid himself with his 2 brothers under the hole of the  
O. H. He said dont you move or speak if you hear  
people outside - all silent - Long towards daylight a big  
noise, people came up north side, bucket fell over to the  
north. & they opened the O. H. & came in - all - Little boy  
said I want you O. H. to be big - the two others be kept -  
still said not a word, but Y. got up & moved around.  
made fire - people said who made the fire that is  
man said now Y. b. came in sight & laughed. - They said  
what is the matter with us we have slept too long -  
Y. b. said yes you slept, you boast of fighting, I guess  
but you no men you all get killed but I'm a man  
I made you all alive again - They said build good fire  
we want to sweat. women & all alive. men said to summer  
you found beans & make us bread will go hunt.  
cell sweat. next day they all went hunting - Now Bears  
could kill these people no more for the Y. b. was too  
strong for them - Bears often chased but could never catch  
them. Geese also came often but could never either  
catch or still these people. Dove could with one shot kill

all the people were here then

Now doves moved off. - & they went. tore down  
 their s. h. - and they built a new big o. h. - and they said  
 will not get killed any more. - Next morning all went hunting  
 deer. - Two little fawns came from <sup>near</sup> the Blue Creek  
 up to Doves new e. house. went in - said why do you come  
 here - we run away Bears killed our mother last night  
 when she was at Creek trying <sup>soaking</sup> a corn. We played about  
 house. - we went to find her, but bear was there cutting  
 off our mother's meat & roasting it. - she was a woman.  
 she said she was our mother's friend. Now all Doves came  
 at Bears again. - Now the bears came after the fawns. &  
 all Doves got in rock made it grow. he asked everybody  
 where they went. - Now they told fawns go off somewhere we  
 don't want any more trouble with people. - all right - Chief  
 said I'll fix my s. h. tight & good. Now Bear woman came  
 they heard B. m. running around outside but all the D. people  
 were inside but they kept still. Now she tried to break s. h. in  
 but couldn't do it. B. could jump 100 yards at a time.  
 And Doves with a shot killed old w. bear.

Chicken Hawk (Black pine nut, no meat inside)

Ukildu was a man <sup>who</sup> lived over at Lacrupa on  
 the mountain <sup>opposite</sup> <sup>to</sup> <sup>the</sup> <sup>mountain</sup> <sup>where</sup> <sup>the</sup> <sup>two</sup> <sup>mountains</sup> <sup>met</sup>. He  
 had a little house, <sup>and</sup> <sup>one</sup> <sup>man</sup> <sup>lived</sup> <sup>by</sup> <sup>himself</sup> <sup>in</sup> <sup>it</sup> <sup>all</sup> <sup>alone</sup>.  
 he talked to himself and all make a pile of pine bark  
 and ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> <sup>fire</sup> <sup>will</sup> <sup>fly</sup> <sup>out</sup> <sup>of</sup> <sup>it</sup> <sup>in</sup> <sup>a</sup> <sup>spark</sup> <sup>like</sup>  
 that, if a it hits a man it will kill him. but if it falls  
 to the ground it will die out. He <sup>made</sup> <sup>a</sup> <sup>fire</sup>, then he talked  
 to it and said send out a spark all the time. Perhaps some  
 people will come to night if they do you play at them, now

went way out & built fire & all went out, hunting and  
as they Bat got near the fire they tried to drive him away.  
B. said dont you push me so. They went off East towards <sup>Beaver</sup>  
(Sugar Pine place) - ~~Chautauque~~ <sup>Teascha</sup> - Bat said  
wait for me. I want you to rest a little all stopped  
Now Bat made a spring of water right there by rushing  
I see drink. <sup>and</sup> ~~then~~ <sup>went on</sup> ~~then~~ B. first of all killed a  
deer & <sup>before any other men killed one this</sup> Beavers took them, stole them - Bat said I know  
you would do this - Old man B. did this <sup>stealing</sup> ~~then~~ they began to  
fight <sup>right away</sup> ~~all~~ came up together all against bat & all began  
to strike at him & fight. They tried to slash him with  
their blunt knives but couldnt he said im a man <sup>a good fighter</sup> you

Owl ran after Bat ran his fingers

the this way. Beaver split <sup>the Huddle</sup> open  
up & down. <sup>was the</sup> Bat on ground built a fire over him  
& burned him up. <sup>Beauty</sup> He left the <sup>bleak</sup> meat & bones of the  
woman there, but took <sup>skin</sup> the hide home. They surrounded the  
fire & waited for the spirit <sup>of Bat</sup> to burst out but it didn't & the  
fire all burned down & men they all went home.

Chickens Hawk (red winged & tailed)

Laurwalila. he had a house this side of Wilkerson's  
at Kewarnatic. (this side of Oak Run) A cave, or rock  
house or place. All his people were killed off only a few  
left. Now he sat and sung & cried and said it looks  
as though I were not a man when people bet my people  
on. Now when he cried all the people living in the North-  
South East & West heard him & said Laurwalila is crying  
I dont know what makes him and all went onto mountains  
around & listened for his plaintive cry & song was  
very beautiful and all liked to hear it, but they said  
somebody must have killed some of his people perhaps  
his wife or brother. Now C. H. said to his people I want  
you to make clothes out of rock & put on so people cannot  
kill us - some said how can we do it this rock is hard  
we cannot cut it. C. H. said pound up the rock into dirt  
mix water with it. Men spread it out like a blanket  
then they got them all a rock blanket in this way which  
they put around themselves. A young L. one of old L. Boys  
said I'm a man I'm going to fight and all day every day  
he sat making flint arrow points. Old C. H. said there  
were too many against my people that is why they were beaten.  
Now old man C. H. sung & piled up rocks for his dead  
people he never stopped crying. Y. man said father  
dont cry too much, perhaps these Southern people will



Kill no too. Next morning old man said I'm going  
out to where my people were killed I've never been  
there yet; and he started & went west and as he went  
he cried all the time, and people coming up from  
the South heard him, & they said I thought we had  
killed off all those people but I hear one crying.  
Another said there are too many of those C. H. people  
we can't kill all. Now the Wintu sat down Little blackbird,  
Robin, Yellow Hammer, Jay bird - all kinds of people  
were with these Wintu. They sat & listened to C. H.'s cry  
now C. H. was on a mountain & as he looked off he saw  
these Wintu in the valley and as he lay on the ground rolling  
around he tried the string to his bow. Now Wintu saw him  
& came up to him & Blackbird said Cousin I come to you  
C. H. said don't call me Cousin - and he got up & shot and  
with one arrow killed several men. They shot at him but  
not one would go in all broke, for he had on stone blankets  
all over, stone body - Now chief of Wintu Crow said  
stop, he will kill you all if you keep fighting. Now Wintu  
all stood together on North side and C. H. followed them  
and as he went he kept pulling the string of his bow - Now  
he stop, and with that one arrow killed all the Wintu that  
were there except one. Ijagmitcainaw awful pretty as  
he flies in the sun, small sort of bright bug fly, he was left  
and he went home. C. H. said you go home & tell your  
people what has happened - Fly went home crying - C. H.  
went home too. Y. Hauke said perhaps my C. H. has been  
killed he don't come back quick, the Wintu Indians are  
always watching to kill my people - and he started off  
to hunt and met C. H. and as he got near he called out  
Where have you been. C. H. listened and again boy called  
then C. H. said don't come on the north side, come  
straight lots of people have been men & have nearly  
killed me to-day. Now C. H. had picked up the bones  
of his people wherever he could find them as he traveled

and he now had a big pack on his back. - Then he told his people to get wood & build fire he said I'm pack<sup>ed</sup> the bones of my people I am lonesome for my people. The people packed home lots of manzanita wood - C. H. said now eat and sleep to night. Y. C. H. said why do you talk so gay you seem to be good always you cry before. Yes C. H. said I've beaten the Doutham people to day. Then he told his people all sleep on the north side to night & about middle of night <sup>all</sup> built a fire <sup>don't say what kind</sup> but all sleep don't move. Now he had a sharp stick smooth that he kept in the house. And he told people to put a big basket near the fire place & fill it with water & then he covered up the basket with a piece of tula carpet. - Now middle of the night all alone his people all sound asleep he built a fire & heated rocks put them in the bucket near the fire & put lay down & watched the bucket & he said rocks not hot enough & again he heated rocks put men in & put in all his sack of bones then a cross top of bucket he put his little sharp stick and as he moved the stick it made the water boil hard, now the old man covered his head with his blanket didn't look & it boiled hard then, the bucket burst and all the people were there, the stick flew up out of the bucket and down on the ground and all the bark came off in little bits & every little bit of bark became a person one of C. H. people. now they walked several times around inside a house. And men went up to old C. H. & pulled off his blanket & said why do you sleep so long brother, build us a fire we want to sweat, now all got up & built a fire, and the newly alive men said bring us water we are dry, we have come from a long ways. They brought water & all drank heartily as though they dry. Now all danced and sweat. Now old C. H. put a bucket full of water on the south side of <sup>his</sup> house. Now all went & swam in the creek, & came back. Old C. H. went around to all those he had brought to life rubbed men all over, and rubbed off their skin & said you were dead men but I have made you alive again, now they all had all new skin & he said now will eat. They ate only salmon nothing else. Night came again. again all sweat, old C. H. said I want you all to sweat & be strong I'm not going to be beaten



women provided manzanita & acorns &c. - told boys  
to get wood. women told children to watch out. they did. - Men  
came home with deer. Noon most all men home & they saw  
people coming from the south, and all had white feathers on their  
heads. Children, a boy saw them & called out people are coming  
run! - the people took all & tried to run away. Some threw  
away their young children they were so afraid. Minutis came  
right up to camp. Some sent for the rest of the Aosa men to come  
from hunting & they all began fighting. Old C. H. said give me time  
dont kill me too quick will have a long day yet. Now  
all C. H.'s people came threw away their deer meats & came quick  
Southern people picked up all the children they could get hold  
of. C. H. said youve stole my people always, but now youll not <sup>take</sup>  
them, & he shot & every arrow killed many people. Now Southern  
people kept coming all the time faster than old men could kill them.  
Old C. H. killed & killed and middle of P.M. only one, little  
fly was left & C. H. sent him home to tell his people. This fly C. H.  
couldnt kill him, as fast as he shot him into flesh would fall off  
but a string was always left between the parts. So C. H. got tired  
& let him go w<sup>th</sup> him to go home & he started off but he slipped  
back and hid behind the house to shoot C. H. and he shot at him  
but C. H. had his blanket on. Not one of C. H.'s people were killed  
for all had on their stone blankets. - Now C. H. called out I  
want all you women & children to come back will have a big dance  
all came, and all began to dance. C. H. skaped the Southern  
Indians and the children danced holding the skulls. Now fly  
saw them dancing with the skulls of his people and he was very  
mad but could do nothing for his arrows wouldnt go into them.  
Now they tied the skulls to sticks and held the stick in their hands  
and as they danced dragged the skulls around. C. H. said "I want  
you might to come" and then daylight quick I want to  
see more people come so I can fight again. The dance enough  
now. Night came that moment & all the people fell asleep.  
That night fly came to try & kill C. H. with a lumie,  
a spear with flint on the end he thought he could creep in  
& spear him in the heart, and he struck him in the heart  
but it only made a scratch crosswise as it slipped off  
the stone - Men C. H. said get up my people, somebody

was come to kill us, they speared one lake a loch &  
look around outside - all got up. took a light & went  
out could see nobody. C. H. said "Daylight Come" I'm  
afraid I guess it is Fly who has tried to kill me. perhaps  
there are more I don't think one man would come alone.  
Day came that moment & all got up. and began cooking  
and some went out to watch. Now one man on the West called  
out I see the back of one man. now they backed him. as he  
went west. Got way below Cow Creek. Two men. C. H.'s boys  
now they sat down on a hill and looked west saw lots of people.  
and they heard these Southern people mourning for their dead.  
The two boys talked together said Chief Crow has got lots of  
people I thought we must have killed them all. Lets go  
home. said we have found a large place & many people. Old  
C. H. said I'm not afraid will move west to-morrow.  
as far as Oak Run. They did & put up houses near a spring  
of water. Middle of day. C. H. sent people for pine nuts but they had  
none. I like to eat deer meat, but I'm afraid to go hunting. - One man  
came from the West & said get your bows & arrows Southern  
people are near us. They came up calling you are all dead now, you  
are not men enough for us you are like women you can't  
fight. I'm chief - It was Crow the chief who talked.  
C. H. said I'm a man & he began shooting. They shot all over  
C. H.'s body but to no avail. He darted in every way & all the  
arrows that hit him broke. & he called Crow you are like an  
old woman you can't fight - you ought to know that my  
people are alive again & now you cannot kill us. I'll  
not die but I'll kill you all. - Stop now. I don't want to kill  
you all go home & stay there now most of winter killed and  
they stopped. - Crow said I have more men strong ones.  
Bowstring of deer sinews = Djohyace manitri is a  
strong man I'll bring him with me, and all his people  
next time. - C. H. said I'd like to see that man. -  
Crow said this man killed your people in old times. all  
right C. H. said bring him quick. Now Southern people  
started home. now C. H. moved further south

Camped. below Woodman's. Night came. Another B. H.  
lived up at Millville & old C. H. sent for him and in  
bire I want more men to help me. Now will hire humming  
bird he runs fast. to go for C. H. at Millville - H. Bird  
started went quick with one step - went from Woodman's  
to Millville. At Bewafdzamauna where  
C. H. lives I came for you wanted over here  
to give help at Hasturpamauna Palky place.  
~~to~~ C. H. came ~~with~~ ~~house~~ people all practicing  
shoot C. H. says take supper my cousin is  
hungry, etc. then said I'm going to fight  
tomorrow. I'd like to steal 3 Crow & black  
birds daughters & get them to carry water for  
me. All night says C. H. I'd like to see these  
people never saw. I want daylight come  
quiet. I want you women cook breakfast  
early I want to go out before <sup>it's</sup> breakfast  
over. Again practice shooting & running  
Women all get up sing & dance & brought  
each one arrow to the man. Men went  
away. One man <sup>had</sup> built a fire outside  
as they came up each one hit it ~~in~~ ~~address~~  
with club. Went <sup>to</sup> west. near Woodman's  
they are about 2 miles from Crow's place. They saw  
Crow & the bird women going out to dig roots and get  
seed. The men hid. C. H. - I says I don't want  
the women. I want to attack the town. May  
be they are play from game you run up 3 or  
4 & see what they doing. They went & see  
which best road. They went playing there  
some women crying. Ran back with wood.  
Saw "No one there" C. H. - I. send lets go down  
water. Help close to brush so they shouldn't see  
us. He flanked the rancheria surrounded  
or One woman saw & gave notice Gaji  
Crow called on all to fight with bows

All did go fight. <sup>B.S.</sup> Dyogyan mann here too  
with bow. B.S. You always boasting I want  
to see fighting to-day. C.H. Kill women & children  
good many. Gaji comes on fighting from the  
West. All arrows flew back from C.H.

About noon all bows & arrows killed at hand.  
They went for the women on road home and captured  
all. C.H. people had big dance. Gave women  
beakathu dressed & loads. ~~Evening all Melvella~~  
~~people went home took 5 girls. C.H. 1.~~

Says I guess I go home now. These people would  
never let me alone when I hunted (now  
I killed them. C.H. 2. Says I don't want  
to go home yet I want a dance to night  
all night all stay to-night & go home to  
morrow. They danced all night.

After breakfast next morning C.H. 1 says  
Well divide all. They did C.H. 2 got 5  
girls C.H. 1. went home to Kewamata  
& all people too. Then he said Well have a  
deer hunt & feast & dance then kill all  
the captives. They got lots deer. Tomorrow  
he says Well have big breakfast & then  
kill all captives. They had breakfast

Captives girls all cry they know they going  
to die. About noon they took them  
out surrounded them they stood in bunch  
in middle. Now all ready said C.H. 1  
all drew bows & shot all girls in  
heart. That afternoon big dance - toward  
Evening all go home End





pregnated - Mink <sup>asked</sup> said why are you afraid. He let her <sup>go</sup> ~~leave~~  
she went into house Mink followed her. Old man saw  
her & ~~she~~ look out his pipe, put tallow tobacco in and handed it  
to his girl to give to Mink to smoke. Mink watched the old man  
girl handed him <sup>the</sup> pipe <sup>and</sup> said smoke don't be afraid. <sup>wait</sup> girl  
next came Mink's sister at home cried. <sup>she</sup> made a blanket  
out of mountain quail skin & made a bed and spread down  
old man & <sup>of</sup> <sup>the</sup> <sup>girls</sup> <sup>to</sup> <sup>sleep</sup> <sup>there</sup> & told his 2 girls to sleep  
with him. Ducks were going to marry these 2 girls, and now  
girls said <sup>perhaps</sup> <sup>may be</sup> Ducks will be mad. Ducks - Popilla  
lived at Koptcikaina (sharp rock place). South of Quail  
place. Next morning Mink said I'll go home & tell my sister I've  
got women & I'll come to night, he started the girls said bring  
your sister here - when he got near heard his sister crying  
he said sister I came to tell you where I <sup>have</sup> ~~been~~ been, & now you  
go with me. <sup>she</sup> <sup>started</sup> <sup>to</sup> <sup>weep</sup>. <sup>his</sup> <sup>sister</sup> <sup>had</sup> <sup>a</sup> <sup>blanket</sup> <sup>made</sup> <sup>of</sup> <sup>quail</sup> <sup>skin</sup>,  
got to the river both packed <sup>the</sup> <sup>blanket</sup> <sup>on</sup> <sup>the</sup> <sup>quail</sup> <sup>skin</sup>.  
Quail saw them coming & was glad. <sup>he</sup> <sup>said</sup> <sup>come</sup> <sup>out</sup> <sup>I</sup> <sup>want</sup> <sup>to</sup> <sup>see</sup> <sup>you</sup>.  
Mink <sup>had</sup> <sup>many</sup> <sup>boys</sup> & he told them to bring good <sup>food</sup> <sup>for</sup> <sup>me</sup>.  
Mink <sup>stood</sup> <sup>down</sup> <sup>a</sup> <sup>man</sup> <sup>came</sup> <sup>from</sup> <sup>west</sup>. Popilla  
he stood outside saw Mink. <sup>he</sup> <sup>said</sup> <sup>come</sup> <sup>out</sup> <sup>I</sup> <sup>want</sup> <sup>to</sup> <sup>see</sup> <sup>you</sup>.  
you <sup>are</sup> <sup>my</sup> <sup>sister</sup>. <sup>when</sup> <sup>he</sup> <sup>was</sup> <sup>going</sup> <sup>his</sup> <sup>sister</sup>.  
likes you. M. stood close to Duck. I said I thought I was  
going to have those girls. I don't want you to have them, they  
are mine. I pulled out the 2 women from the house.  
M. said all right I must fight take them if <sup>you</sup> <sup>want</sup> <sup>them</sup>.  
2 women cried. I jumped in the river with girls & swam  
down holding them, got home. M. sat at house <sup>his</sup> <sup>sister</sup>.  
said I'll go home you can stay if you like & she went.  
And her brother went too that day the 2 <sup>great</sup> <sup>women</sup> <sup>been</sup> <sup>away</sup>  
from Duck. went to their home, but Mink wasn't there.  
Why didn't you keep that man, give <sup>me</sup> <sup>the</sup> <sup>girls</sup>.  
I will follow our man. They took salmon & came to  
Mink's house. Now Ducks came to old Quail's house  
& fought with him. <sup>he</sup> <sup>helped</sup> <sup>each</sup> <sup>side</sup>.  
They fought with their fists. Hit Quail over head wounded  
him all up. I said go after your girls or I'll kill you.  
Old man said why don't you go. Ducks went stole Mink's  
sister <sup>and</sup> <sup>she</sup> <sup>was</sup> <sup>a</sup> <sup>very</sup> <sup>pretty</sup> <sup>woman</sup>.

Bat had a house below Buggawo Point, and his wife was ~~big~~ <sup>big</sup> frog. - Live Oak. two slams, were now are Bat & Frog turned to beer. - Frog she pounded acorns <sup>used</sup> Bat went to trap mice with little <sup>small</sup> stones for a trap. <sup>every day and</sup> Frog is knocked up & gales. Now Bat came <sup>home</sup> Sundown saw his wife <sup>was</sup> sick, she said go after that woman, Skunk, in pretty dress <sup>marumi</sup> & doctor. B. said I dont want to go, in going to get wood <sup>make a</sup> and sleep man to night. <sup>very sick said B</sup> go & get S. <sup>if I go she wont come</sup> (Everybody goes for her but she wont go anywhere <sup>at last</sup> B. started, got there saw S. sitting in her house <sup>at home</sup> said friend come & see my <sup>my</sup> woman she is <sup>very</sup> sick. I dont want to go its too dark. <sup>said B</sup> B. said I'll get pitch <sup>to</sup> & make light. All right be quick. <sup>when near Buggawo Point</sup> ~~Bat had the porch soon ready and they set out together~~ <sup>she</sup> rubbed the rock with her head. <sup>There</sup> ~~(The rock is near Buggawo Point)~~ <sup>yet and</sup> when a woman is pregnant she wont go near ~~that rock~~ <sup>it</sup> now) S. woman said as she rubbed the rock I dont want B's wife to be sick in that way any more. ~~Now B. came with pitch~~ <sup>the</sup> ~~she started~~ <sup>she</sup> ~~got very sick~~ <sup>stomach</sup> S. woman caught right hold of <sup>her hand</sup> B's wife and pressed B's wife by <sup>Frog's hoof</sup> side. S. kept rubbing <sup>the</sup> that way <sup>was born</sup> ~~now little one~~ <sup>to the</sup> ~~now~~ <sup>ran</sup> Frog woman got up & ran off East. Now ~~skunk was sent for to come~~ <sup>in distance</sup> <sup>as soon as</sup> <sup>they</sup> <sup>ran</sup> women always did so soon as child born went out a little to East & brought wood. Now Bat packed lots of wood. Now another frog woman <sup>who lived nearby</sup> came to Bat, that <sup>night</sup> day she wanted Bat. She intended to have him <sup>before</sup> but the other woman had got ahead of her. Now Bat went home with <sup>the</sup> <sup>being the</sup> <sup>husband</sup> ~~his~~ sick wife. <sup>the</sup> ~~now~~ <sup>angry at</sup> ~~she~~ <sup>said</sup> Take it & feed it. Bat was <sup>angry at</sup> ~~she~~ <sup>said</sup> Why do you do that. In afraid this woman will kill me if I dont go with her. Now sick woman took baby & followed Bat <sup>the door of the house</sup> ~~and~~ <sup>and</sup> said Come out and lets go with this baby to Skunk's it is sick

They advanced <sup>to</sup> these Eastern ones were Teenoya <sup>agreed</sup> Owl was  
the number, <sup>many people</sup> Owl shut his eyes <sup>all the time</sup> in the dance  
Metri <sup>said</sup> dancer way back at the end  
of the people <sup>eye of her eye</sup> (between <sup>the</sup> middle & end) Owl danced  
they came into the <sup>to</sup> ~~town~~ dancing and <sup>by</sup> ~~surrounding~~  
and surrounded the <sup>place</sup> ~~town~~ in their dance. When  
Metri had almost come into <sup>the place</sup> ~~camp~~ he said  
to Owl (in the hearing of all) I have a song  
he had something in a sack (some kind of  
poison.) Owl says When I close my eye <sup>it is good</sup> ~~it~~  
when I open my eye it is poison.

(When he closes his eyes it is night & opens it is day)  
All the <sup>Eastern</sup> ~~Teenoya~~ <sup>Teenoya</sup> came into the town

There <sup>were</sup> ~~are~~ three kinds of bad people among the <sup>people</sup>

One of these says you must not laugh at me when

I dance I dance with one leg and one arm -

This one <sup>is</sup> Yoio'tske. ~~many~~ <sup>up the crowd</sup> ~~who~~ <sup>of</sup> ~~his~~ <sup>good</sup> many of his  
people <sup>say</sup> Metri says Metri says to owl

What <sup>do you mean when</sup> ~~you~~ <sup>say</sup> I shut my eye when I open <sup>it is good</sup> ~~my~~ <sup>it is poison</sup> eye

I have says Metri I have to take <sup>out</sup> my poison

but now <sup>heard this and</sup> ~~the~~ <sup>he</sup> ~~was~~ <sup>was</sup> ~~silent~~ <sup>was</sup> ~~silent~~  
We have <sup>says</sup> ~~nothing~~ <sup>more</sup> Metri ~~said~~ <sup>to</sup> ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> ~~the~~

Are you frightened? You ought to say ~~to~~ <sup>to</sup> ~~me~~ <sup>me</sup>

large ~~and~~ they sat down some died but  
all stared with dry eyes I ~~couldn't~~

wrink ~~and~~ ~~could~~ ~~get~~ ~~into~~ ~~their~~ ~~eyes~~ ~~!!~~

When Metri had done this. Owl opened his  
eyes all the people of Goyumanna died to  
the last one. The Chief <sup>Mudpana Waka</sup> Tanhanga and his  
daughter with the rest. Melowila, the Chief  
of the Eastern people went home with all his  
people ~~and~~ but they took back with them  
all the heads, skins and beautiful  
things that were in Goyumanna.
